Variable Speed Drives as a means to specify sustainable buildings

Eurovent Middle East to host its next 'HVACR Leadership Workshop' focusing on Variable Speed Drives and their impact on energy efficiency

Dubai, 19 August 2019. Eurovent Middle East has announced the next event forming part of its 'HVACR Leadership Workshop' series, which will focus on specifying Variable Speed Drives (VSDs) and takes place at the Le Meridien Dubai Hotel & Conference Centre on 11 September 2019 from 18:00 to 21:00h. The individual topics will be followed by a feedback session and discussion, where participants are invited to discuss any issues related to motors and drives. This includes, for instance:

- EC vs AC motors, what are the differences?
- How to specify to guarantee the right choice of products
- Experiences in the field

Ms Nerissa Deoraj, Director Technical and Regulatory Affairs at Eurovent Middle East outlines the workshop series: "We aim to provide real insight by specialists on various topics related to our industry. A full understanding of available technology is the first step towards achieving improved energy efficiency. Variable Speed Drives have changed the market and increased flexibility in regard to part load or seasonal performance requirements. In this workshop we will take a closer look at what has to be observed when making use of this technology."
